

Privacy Policy:

In plain language, we collect some data about visitors through forms and cookies (small tracking codes) on our site. We use this information to keep in touch with you (if you fill out a contact form or newsletter subscription request, for instance) and to improve the content we provide (by identifying what articles get the most attention and to fix site usability issues, for example).

We don't sell, rent, or otherwise share your personal data with anyone outside of The Center except as necessary to provide a requested service (such as accepting payment).

Further Details

This privacy policy ("Policy") describes the practices of The Center for Supporting Community Health ("The Center") with respect to the gathering and use of personal information submitted to The Center through The Center website (the "The Center Site"). All capitalized terms not defined here, shall be given the same meaning as defined in the The Center for Supporting Community Health General Terms and Conditions ("Terms").

This Policy does not apply to the practices of unrelated third-party service providers or companies accessed through links provided for your convenience from the Sites.

What information we collect

The Center for Supporting Community Health collects certain Nonpublic Personal Information ("NPI") which is submitted by you when enter information (for example, via registration, payment, or a contact form) on the Site. The NPI may include, but may not be limited to:

- Your name
- Name of employer
- Job Title
- Home or office mailing address
- E-mail address
- Telephone numbers
- Credit card information (if applicable).

In addition, when you visit the Sites, we may collect technical and navigational information, such as computer browser type, Internet protocol address, pages visited, and average time spent on our Sites. This information is gathered through the use of cookies. A cookie is a small data text file that a website server writes to your hard-drive when you visit the Sites. A cookie assigns a unique identification to your computer and may be used for security purposes, to facilitate transactions, to personalize the Sites, or to gather information about the visit.

When we disclose your nonpublic personal information

The Center does not disclose NPI to any third party, except for the purposes of providing the Services to you, or as otherwise disclosed in this Policy. We may share NPI to government agencies and law enforcement officials, when we are required to do so.

How we use your nonpublic personal information within The Center

The Center uses NPI collected from Users in order to administer the Services requested by you, to make the Sites more useful, to respond to your queries, and to inform Users of new products and services offered on the Sites.

Your Internet Protocol address and information regarding the web pages on the Sites that you visit, or that linked to the Sites, may also be used to gather broad demographic information, interests, and behavior so that we may better understand our Users. This information may be used, for example, to alert you to software compatibility issues, or it may be analyzed to improve the Sites' design and functionality.

Security

Although the Sites have security measures in place to protect against unauthorized access to and the loss, misuse and alteration of information under our control, we cannot guarantee that such security measures will be sufficient, will not be breached, and that your NPI, Private Information, or other information may not be disclosed or otherwise accessed in an unauthorized manner. Certain information, including NPI and Private Information, may be transmitted by you and to you by unsecured electronic mail. Although it may be illegal to intercept or disclose these messages, these transmissions are not secured.

Opt-out policy

You may at any time request not to be contacted by The Center. "Opt out" requests should be sent to the address indicated on the materials sent by The Center or by replying to the email in which such material was sent.

Linked websites

The Sites provide hypertext links to and framed content from other websites that may be governed by privacy policies that are different from those provided herein. If you leave the Sites, or if you are presented with a framed web page that is branded with the marks of a third party, this Privacy Policy will not apply. You should read the privacy policies of websites reached through the use of links or reached through the interactions with framed content on the Sites. The Center is not responsible for the collection, use, or disclosure of information collected through those websites, and The Center expressly disclaims any and all liability related to such collection, use, or disclosure.

Applicable laws

This Site is published in the United States and is subject to laws of the United States. If you are located in a country outside the United States and voluntarily submit personal information to us, you thereby consent to the general use of such information as provided in this privacy policy and to the transfer of that information to, and/or storage of that information in, the United States.

Revisions to this policy

As the Sites grow and new features are added, or legal requirements change, this Privacy Policy may be amended by posting the amended Privacy Policy on the Sites. The amended Privacy Policy, which will apply to all NPI held by The Center, will automatically be effective 30 days after it is initially posted on the Sites.
